EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) REGULATIONS, 2020

(Cap. 22:04 (Sub. Leg.))

Lifting of Prohibition of Entry into and Exit from Botswana

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that His Excellency the President, in accordance with regulation 30G of the Emergency Powers (COVID-19) Regulations, 2020, has authorised the lifting of the prohibition of entry into and exit from Botswana set out in the Schedule with respect to —

- (a) persons entering and exiting Botswana;
- (b) the processing of visas at ports of entry and at any embassy;
- (c) to places of entry, exit, landing and loading and examination of goods in Botswana; and
- (d) the take-off and landing of aircraft.

For the avoidance of doubt —

- (i) a traveller entering Botswana —
 - (aa) shall present a Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) negative test result not older than 72 hours from the time of departure from country of origin at the port of entry, and
 - (bb) may at his/her own cost be required to undertake immediate COVID-19 testing and isolation or quarantine within the COVID zone;
- (ii) a traveller exiting Botswana shall present a PCR negative test result not older than 72 hours from the time of exit from Botswana at the port;
- (iii) a non-citizen and a non-resident traveller who does not meet the requirements of paragraph (i) (aa) shall not be allowed entry into Botswana.
